
British Keelboat League Finals — Briefing Poole Yacht Club — Arrival

Arrival and parking

- Poole YC will be open to guests wanting to arrive on Thursday night until 22:00 and gates are open from 08:00 on Friday 24th September each day for the finals
- On arrival at the main gate press the call button. If the car park is full you will be able to drop off your kit and will be asked to then **remove your** car.
- Parking tickets for the Poole Harbour Commissioner's car park can be bought over the bar on arrival at Poole YC. If you plan to park your car here, please bring the correct cash and buy your parking permit on arrival:
 - £7.50 per day plus £5 deposit for the parking permit
 - Please return permits and reclaim your deposit on Sunday over the bar when departing
- Teams wishing to train on Thursday 23rd September should contact the office on 01202 672687 to reserve a boat (£75/day; £35/half day) first come first served!
- For information if you wish to bring a camper van, please contact the Poole Yacht Club office 01202 672687. All camper vans must be booked before arrival.






