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CONDITIONS AND TERMS OF HAUL OUT/STORAGE

- 1. Subject to space availability the Club undertakes to handle Members craft endeavouring to meet owners requirements as far as possible.
- 2. Applications for Haul Out & Storage will be dealt with on first come first served basis.
- 3. With the exception of Wooden Hulled Craft (12 weeks) the length of time in the yard is for a maximum of 6 weeks October February (incl.) or 4 weeks February and March. Long Term Storage (max. 22 weeks) will be allocated subject to availability.
- 4. Those craft exceeding their allocated time will be penalized as per General Committee Policy.
- 5. All craft must have suitable support cradles or must be supported by stable rigid blocking approved by the Yard and Haven Committee. Cradles should be in the Yard, clearly named and ready to accept craft and reported to the Bosun not more than one week before notified Haul Out date. ALL cradles and means of support must be removed from the Yard immediately the boat is launched.
- 6. Members must endeavour to keep Car Park and area around their craft clean and ensure that no damage is done to the Car Park surface. All rubbish must be removed from the yard.
- 7. All work to be undertaken on craft by outside contractors must be cleared with the office BEFORE work commences. All outside contractors must report to the office before starting work on craft on Club premises and show Proof of Indemnity Insurance.
- 8. Members must provide on their craft, and maintain in efficient working order, at least one suitable Fire Extinguisher.
- 9. Craft and gear are repaired, worked on, moved, stored and otherwise managed and kept at the sole risk of the owner, and the Club and its employees accept no responsibility for loss, damage or delay occurring from any cause whatsoever.

The owner must therefore ensure that his craft and/or property is adequately insured against all risks and effect insurance against Third Party risks for a minimum of £3,000,000 as he may be liable for damage caused by his craft, himself or his crew whilst on or about the Clubs premises. The member is responsible for all health and safety issues concerning their boat whilst on the hard and the Club accepts no liability after the craft has been blocked off by the yard staff. All persons using any part of the Club premises and/or facilities for whatever purpose and whether by invitation or otherwise do so at their own risk, the exception to this clause being to the extent that such loss, theft or damage may be caused by the negligence or wilful acts of the Club, or those for whom the Club are responsible.

- 10. The method of hauling any craft shall be at the sole discretion of the General Committee.
- 11. All craft with Haven Berths (Winter period) must be launched by March 21st. Swinging Mooring vessels must be ready for re-launch by April 2nd. The Committee reserve the right to withdraw Haul Out/Re-Launch facilities from members who in their opinion do not endeavour to meet the Haul Out/Launch conditions
- 12. Haul Out/H.P.C./Re-Launch programme operates Monday to Friday inclusive, excluding Bank Holidays
- 13. The Club reserves the right to measure all boats to confirm compliance with Haven Byelaw 9.
- 14. Any vessels found to be in excess of the allowable overall lengths will be referred to the General Committee.
- 15. All boats are entitled to 2 weeks free storage if they are relaunched before 23rd of December 2023.
