

Now the nights are drawing in, **Friendly Fridays** is **moving to Sundays**. Come and join us for a cruise round the harbour in good company with safety cover on a Sunday afternoon.

First one will be this week (*Sunday 20th September*) then each week until the end of November - remember the sea stays warm for a long time and there can be some glorious sunny afternoons!

It's all very easy - have your boat rigged and ready to launch for a briefing by the slip at **1.00pm** where we'll give details of the route we plan to take. This will be suitable for dinghies, dayboats and R19's.

Youth sailors and new members are very welcome. There is no training/coaching from the safety boats so sailors will need to be able to launch and recover their boats safely and be able to sail around the harbour unaided. But we will always try to accommodate everyone where possible. This is all about getting out on the water and having a relaxing sail (so we operate a lower wind limit of max average 16 knots).

Feel free to ask any questions below but as anyone that has sailed on a Friday evening will testify, this is all a pretty relaxed affair and should be a perfect way to end the week.

There is a WhatsApp group that you can join - when you come along for a sail, we will join you to it. There is no charge for anyone who has paid race fees, and a £5 charge from now until the end of the November for anyone who has not paid race fees, this is to contribute towards the RIBs which are used as safety cover.
